Our band members currently represent 20 schools throughout the area. Although most of our members are from Red Deer, there are young people travelling from as far south as Olds, as far north as Edmonton, as far west as Spruce View, as well as many communities in between.

Over the past 49 years the Royals have developed into an award winning band performing, competing, and delighting crowds both locally and internationally. In 2017 our band was awarded a Gold Medal for our performance at the World Music Contest in Kerkrade Netherlands. The Royals are also actively involved as volunteers in the community.

The Royals are holding their 2018 March-a-thon wind up on June 3rd at The Lindsay Thurber Sports Field. At this time, we will perform our final home show prior to the competition in Calgary during the Calgary Stampede.
